## DISTRICT 23 CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

*Supplement to the national Conditions of Contest*

### Unit Final games

1. Two multi-unit Unit Final games will be held. Members of any unit in District 23 who have qualified at the club level will be invited to compete. (See **Unit Level Participation** in national CoC.)
2. Unit Finals will be flighted games, unless participation warrants a stratified game.
3. 60% of the field in each Unit Final will qualify to the District Final
4. Club qualifiers may only play in one Unit Final in a given flight. If a player has qualified for more than one flight, and is eligible for more than one, they may play in each flight in each of the two Unit Final games.

### District Final game

1. One District Final will be held as a flighted two-session playthrough event.
2. The ACBL Open+ convention chart is permitted for Flight A
